Vocabulary

Coercive: to persuade someone forcefully to do something that they are unwilling to do.

Retaliatory: a **retaliatory** action is one that is harmful to someone who has done something to harm you.

Nascent: (especially of a process or organization) just coming into existence and beginning to display signs of future potential.

Undermine: lessen the effectiveness, power, or ability of, especially gradually or insidiously.

Proliferation: rapid increase in the number or amount of something.
