We use 'was' with I, he, she, it or singular nouns. We use 'were' with we, you, they or plural nouns.

Was	Were
I was happy.	We were happy.
He was happy. She was happy.	You were happy.
It was happy.	They were happy.
The dog was happy.	The children were happy.
