When to use 'was and were' ?

We use **was** and **were** to show the past.

We use '**was**' with I, he, she, it or singular nouns.

We use '**were**' with we, you, they or plural nouns.

Was	Were
I was happy.	We were happy.
He was happy. She was happy.	You were happy.
It was happy.	They were happy.
The dog was happy.	The children were happy.
