VOCABULARY

Edgy: (in this context) at the forefront of a trend; experimental or avant-garde.

Stud: (in this context) a small piece of metal jewellery that is put through a part of your body such as your ear or nose.

Aura: a feeling or character that a person or place seems to have.

Ruffles: (in this context) a series of small folds made in a piece of cloth or sewn onto it, as decoration.

Pleats: a narrow fold in a piece of cloth made by pressing or sewing two parts of the cloth together.

Garish: unpleasantly bright.

Worn-In: noun phrase wear and tear, implying the sense "process of being degraded with use."
