Vocabulary

Agflation: a significant rise globally in price of food.

Biofuel: a fuel derived immediately from living matter.

Cost-push (inflation): relating to or denoting inflation caused by increased labour or raw material costs.

Demand-pull (inflation): relating to or denoting inflation caused by an excess of demand over supply.

Outstrip: To exceed.

Surge: 1) a sudden large increase, typically a temporary one. 2) (as a verb): to increase suddenly and powerfully.

Introduction
