# Vocabulary

**Populous:** having a large population.

**Archduke:** a chief duke, in particular (formerly) the son of the Emperor of Austria.

**Assassinate:** murder/kill (an important person) for political or religious reasons.

**Terrorist:** a person who uses violence and goes against the law to scare people, especially for political reasons.

**Split:** divide into two or more groups; break into parts.

**Ditch** (synonym "Trench"): a narrow channel dug at the side of a road or field, to hold or carry away water.

**Armistice:** an agreement made by opposing sides in a war to stop fighting for a certain time; a truce.

**Sink (past participle 'sunk')**: go down below the surface of something, especially of a liquid.
