Vocabulary

Slave: a person who is the legal property of another and is forced to obey them.

BCE: BCE (Before Common Era) and BC (Before Christ) mean the same thing-previous to year 1 CE (Common Era).

Monk: a member of a religious community of men typically living under vows of poverty and obedience.

Moral: a lesson that can be derived from a story or experience.

Well: a place where water springs up from the Earth, a hole dug into the ground to obtain this water. (in this context).

Quench: satisfy (one's thirst) by drinking.

Quick as a flash (idiom): (especially of a person's response or reaction) very quickly.

Leap: jump or spring a long way, to a great height, or with great force.
