

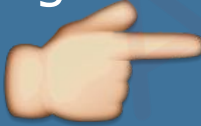

Vocabulary

Craving: a powerful desire for something.

Phenomenon: a fact or situation that is observed to exist or happen, especially one whose cause or explanation is in question.

Portfolio: a range of investments held by a person or organisation.

Spiral: show a continuous and dramatic increase.

Sock Away (Idiom): to place something, such as money, into reserve; to store something in a secure place.

Bust (as a verb): break, split, or burst.

Levy (as a noun): an act of levying a tax, fee, or fine.

Levy (as a verb): impose (a tax, fee or fine)

Domicile: the country that a person treats as their permanent home, or lives in and has a substantial connection with.
