# Vocabulary

**Affiliated:** officially attached or connected to an organization.

**Enrolled:** officially be registered as a member of an institution or a student on a course.

**Weird:** very strange and unusual, unexpected, or not natural.

**Mingling:** move among and engage with others at a social function.

**Stretch (or spread) his wings:** extend one's activities and interests or start new ones.

**Bucks:** dollars (informal).

**Bite off more than you chew:** to try to do something that is too difficult for you (informal).

**Burn-out:** ruin one's health or become completely exhausted through overwork.

**Leeway:** the amount of freedom to move or act that is available.
