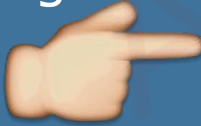

Revision Of Phrasal Verbs

- **Phrasal Verbs** are verbs with more than one word. (Normally the verb followed by a preposition or/and an adverb).
- Examples: pick up, put down, turn on, turn off
- Phrasal verbs are also called 'two-part verbs' and 'three-part verbs.'

PHRASAL VERBS

A phrasal verb is a combination of:
a verb and a preposition
a verb and an adverb
a verb with both an adverb and a preposition
