Vocabulary

Stink: have a strong unpleasant smell.

Stink up: (informal) to make something or some place smell very bad.

Tantrums: an uncontrolled outburst of anger and frustration, typically in a young child.

Discipline: the practice of training people to obey rules.

Recline: (of a seat) be able to have the back moved into a sloping position.

Chatty: liking to talk a lot in a friendly, informal way.

Armrest: the part of a chair that supports the arm.
