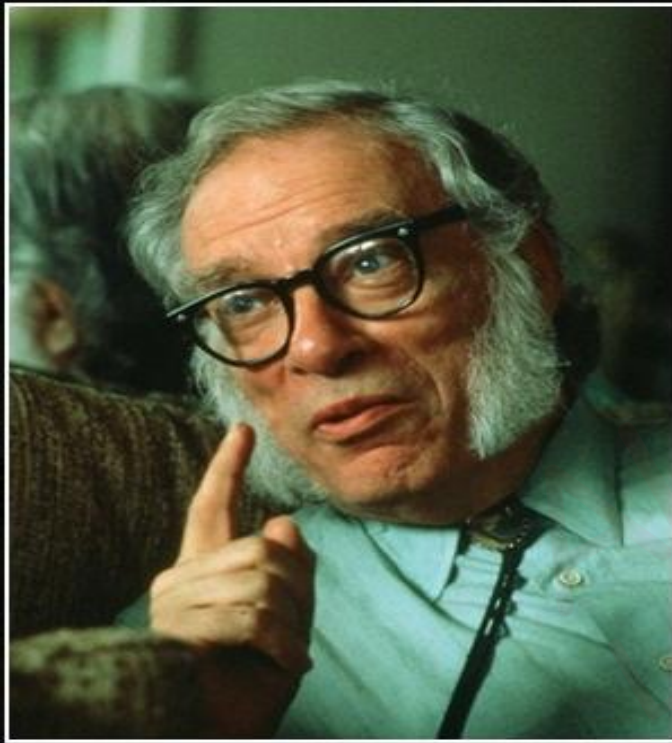

VOCABULARY

Iconic: present, appearing, or found everywhere.

Prescient: having or showing knowledge of events before they take place.

Foreshadow: be a warning or indication of (a future event).

Advent: the arrival of a notable person or thing.

Cite: refer to (a passage, book, or author) as evidence for or justification of an argument or statement, especially in a scholarly work.

Trope: a significant or recurrent theme.

Extrapolation: the action of estimating or concluding something by assuming that existing trends will continue or a current method will remain applicable.

Conjecture: an opinion or theory so formed or expressed; guess; speculation.
