Minted: to make (coins, money, etc.) by stamping metal.

The Fertile Crescent: a region in Western Asia between the Tigris and Euphrates rivers, important to the growth of human civilization

The Silk Road: The Silk Road or Silk Route was an ancient network of trade routes that were for centuries central to cultural interaction originally through regions of Eurasia connecting the East and West.
