

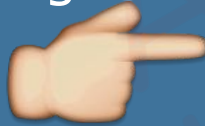

VOCABULARY

Spectrum: a broad range of varied but related ideas or objects, the individual features of which tend to overlap so as to form a continuous series or sequence. For example: A spectrum of political ideas.

Pragmatic: of or relating to a practical point of view or practical considerations. For example: Jenna's pragmatic approach to inventory management has increased productivity by forty percent.

Strand: a thread or threadlike part of anything. For example: The plot had various interwoven strands.

Mitigate: to make less severe. For example: Saving from your monthly income, mitigates shortage of funds after retirement.

Contortionist: a person who performs gymnastic feats involving contorted (twisted or bent) postures. For example: A contortionist's body has to be very supple.
