VOCABULARY

Sentiment: (In this context) a feeling or emotion. For example: The movie evokes intense and varied sentiments.

Catalogue: a complete list of items, typically one in alphabetical or other systematic order, in particular. For example: The Burlington's summer catalogue has some new products.

Hamper: (In this context) a basket with a carrying handle and a hinged lid, used for food, cutlery, and plates on a picnic. For example: My grandma was carrying a huge hamper filled with bread, cheese, jam and fruits.

Significant Other: a person with whom someone has an established romantic or sexual relationship. For example: Claire has been Don's significant other for years, however, they haven't announced any plans of an engagement yet.
