Vocabulary

Potent: very powerful, forceful, or effective.

Overdose: an amount of a drug or medicine that is too much and usually dangerous.

Prevalence: the fact or condition of being prevalent; commonness.

To **revoke:** put an end to the validity or operation of (a decree, decision, or promise).

To **drop out:** abandon a course of study.

Detrimental: causing harm or damage.

Handcuff: two metal or plastic rings joined by a short chain that lock around a prisoner's wrists.

Forged: to make an illegal copy of something in order to deceive.
