Vocabulary

Famine: a situation in which there is not enough food for a great number of people, causing illness and death, or a particular period when this happens.

Sabotage: to damage or destroy equipment, weapons, or buildings in order to prevent the success of an enemy or competitor.

Veneration: to honour or very much respect a person or thing.

Musculature: the position and structure of the muscles.

Realism: paintings, films, books, etc. that try to represent life as it really is.

Expressionism: a style of art, music, or writing, found especially in the 1900s, that expresses extreme feelings.
